# Checklist for Reviewing PRs

## Section One: The Diff

Look at the diff that github/bitbucket/whatever provides and check for:

- LESS/SASS variable usage
- Semantic HTML (headings in order, tags used appropriately)
- Accessibility (alt tags, labels for inputs, table summaries)
- Markup patterns used consistently
- Any duplicate CSS that has been created elsewhere already
- Flexbox/Grid usage
- Code formatting/style according to the team's guidelines
- Documentation
- Typos

## Section Two: The App

Check out the branch and spin up the app to check for:

- Actual expected functionality
- Parity with the designs/discussed changes
- Responsive transitions and awkward places
- Rendering bugs in various supported browsers
- Regressions
- Edge use cases (error/empty states, long names, data variation etc.)
- Logic (does it make sense? Does micro copy need to be adjusted?)
- Typos
